PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION:

This house is a fine example of the Colonial Revival construction. The core is a 2½ story, five bay house with exterior end chimneys which break through the gable ends of the house. There is a strong cornice framing the roof. The 30 x 60 core was constructed of semi-coursed stone c. 1920. Each of the windows has a jack arch and shutters (except some round headed windows in the gable ends which have no shutters and a rounded stone arch). A pent roof separates the first and second floors, and a small gabled entry hood breaks through the pent roof on the façade. Three gabled roof dormers adorn the façade as well. The rear of the house is quite unexpected. Two 2-story wings that seem to be additions from the front appear original on the rear. The center of the rear is marked by a projecting 2½ story gable with a round headed window on the third floor, a tripartite window on the second, and a nice entry porch on the first floor. The entry porch has two round unfluted columns supporting an entablature and a flying eagle sculpture. The dormers and windows on the rear follow the pattern of the façade. The pent roof rounds the corner on one end of the rear and becomes part of a small porch with a hipped roof resting on three square columns. This porch is partially enclosed with a privacy fence.

Associated Resources

- (1) **Garage/Carriage House.** This one story building is a recent example of the Colonial Revival manner of construction. The gable-front façade consists of a large pedimented gable resting on a strong entablature. Two fluted Doric columns on the corners of the façade support the gable, and a large fanlight in the gable hints at the eighteenth century. Behind this façade is a one story building with a hipped roof oriented ninety degrees off the axis of the façade. (C)
- (2) **Stone Outbuilding.** This building was constructed of uncoursed stone. It has a narrow door under a large stone arch. A scar on the side of the building leaves evidence of a former gabled addition now removed. The upper portion of the building is frame. A rear portion of the building is a one story frame addition. Key elements are the medieval arch above the arched wooded door and the small buttress where the former addition was once located (C)

This resource is associated with Dawesfield NR properties (525 & 555 Lewis Lane).

Classification: This house is in excellent condition and is a Class I resource. Its other resources, particularly the stone outbuilding, are also important.
