

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION:

This house, c. 1790, is a Colonial style house consisting of three parts. The core is a four bay wide, two story, end gabled structure with an end-gabled wood shingled roof. The roof extends on the NE end to cover a two story main stone addition. A molded cornice runs along the eaves. Details include flush brick chimneys on each end of the core, a deeply inset paneled door with three light transom, and 6 over 6-light sash windows. The windows have a thick molded surround, a rear feature for this rather vernacular house. There are also two large (2 over 4 light) attic windows under the exposed gabled end. The masonry is rough fieldstone. The main addition is attached to the NE end of the core, and originally was a 1.5 story stone structure with a shed roof. Later framework was attached to the top of the walls to create the present two-story structure, in line with the core. The framework is covered in clapboard. There is one window on each floor, slightly smaller than those on the core. An early twentieth century porch addition is attached to the SW end. It is an enclosed structure with modillion course under the eaves. Its flat roof is accessed from a multi-pained door on the second floor of the SE end of the core. With additions, the house measures 40' by 18'.

Classification: The house is in excellent shape. Due to alterations, it is a Class I resource. (It also is located in a modern development and thus has lost its context as a farmhouse.)
