Application for permits shall be made at least 15 days in advance of the date of the display or discharge of fireworks.

1. Attach one (1) copy of your liability and property insurance policy in the amount of One Million (\$1,000,000.00) naming Whitpain Township as an additional insured.
2. Attach one (1)-notarized copy of proof of workers compensation insurance which names Whitpain Township as a Policy Certificate Holder along with the Contractors Federal and State employer identification number.

3. Attach one (1) copy of detailed plans and specifications of the proposed site. Such plans must be clear, clean, concise and legible, and submitted a standard scale on paper of a standard size.
 - a. The location and legal description of the site including its boundaries, relationship with adjacent properties, public right-of-way, significant buildings and utilities.
 - b. Inventory for products to be stored and handled.
 - c. Description of fixed or portable fire protection. Two Class-A pressurized water extinguishers and one a Class-D extinguisher.
 - d. Name of contractor and emergency contacts.
 - e. Certification of Unit(s)
 - f. Each pyrotechnic device fired during a performance shall be separated from the audience by a minimum of 15 ft (4.6 m) or twice the fallout radius of the device, whichever is greater. No flammable or combustible items shall be within fifteen feet of the units. (Above and around)
 - g. There must be a fire watch during the event.
 - h. Place your fire alarm system on test with the alarm monitoring company just prior to, and 15 minutes after the display.

The indoor fireworks shall be arranged, located, discharged and fired in a manner that, in the opinion of the Fire Marshal, shall not be a hazard to property or endanger any person. Unfired fireworks and trash that remain after the display is concluded shall be immediately disposed of in an approved, safe manner by the contractor.

The display or discharge of indoor fireworks shall comply with the requirements of Chapter 56, International Code Council Prevention Code, 2018 Edition, as adopted.
